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Trishna Wild Life Sanctuary



Situated about 111 km from Agartala, Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary is another protected area dedicated to the vital mission of the conservation of nature, wildlife and biodiversity which is frequented by visitors and tourists. Its area is 194.704 sq. km. Apart from the healthy forest coverage and plants, the great attraction of this Wildlife Sanctuary is a sizeable population of Gaur or the Indian Bison. Trishna also harbours a good stock of avifauna population which is integral to the prevalent ecosystem of the Sanctuary. Another facet of Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary is the fact that it is also the habitat of and home to the Hoolock Gibbon - a highly endangered ape species of the Indian subcontinent, and primates like the Capped Langur and the Golden Langur.

A huge lake under deep forest surroundings with boating facilities is one of the beautiful attractions of Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary. Apart from this, there is a nice butterfly park, a View Tower and amazing walking trails through forest area.

How to Reach:

There is no need of entry formalities like Restricted Area Permit (RAP) or Inner Line Permit (ILP) to visit Tripura

Air - The State Capital, Agartala is well connected by air with Delhi, Kolkata, Guwahati and Chennai. The M.B.B. Airport at Agartala is 120 km away from Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary, Belonia Sub-Division in the South Tripura District.

Rail - Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary is connected by rail with Belonia Rail Station which is about 19 km away. Bus, tourist cabs and local transport are available at Belonia Railway Station to

reach Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary.

Road - Trishna Wildlife Sanctuary is well connected by road with Agartala via Sonamura or via Udaipur. It is at a distance of 111 km from Agartala, 60 km from Udaipur, 57 km from Sonamura and 19 km from Belonia. Luxury coaches both of private travel agencies and Public Sector Transport Corporation including tourist cabs, and small cars ply on this road.

Local Transport:

Tourist cabs and bus services are available to and from Agartala, Sonamura, Udaipur and also for local sightseeing. Tourist cabs are also arranged by Tourism Department at Agartala Airport Tourist Information Centre on hire for transportation.

Entry Formalities:

There is no need of entry formalities like Restricted Area Permit (RAP) or Inner Line Permit (ILP) to visit Tripura.
