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

CHABIMURA

Chabimura is famous for its panels of rock carvings on the steep hilly wall on the bank of Gomati. There are huge images carved of Shiva, Vishnu, Kartika, Mahisasurmardini Durga and other Gods and goddesses. These images date back to 15th-16th centuries AD. Chabimura is 30 km away from Udaipur and 12 km from Amarpur Sub-Division. These beautiful images are curved with a lot of dexterity on the rocky faces of Devtamura which is steep at 90 degrees. The hill ranges are covered with thick jungles and one can reach this abode of gods only after trekking through these jungles. The road leading to the river bank where the rock cut images exist is itself a treat to the eye. The area is also an eco-Tourism centre.

The first panel is just on the other side of the bank. It measures 10.3 m in (height) and is spread over an area 28 m (length) and is south facing. The area to the right of the panel extends up to 60 m where some other images existed. At present some of the images are lost due to sliding of rock panels.

The 2nd image is that of Mahishasurmardini and is about one km away from the 1st panel. It is curved at a height of 10 meter from the river bed. The local tribe worshipped it as Chakramma. This is one of the largest reliefs of Goddess present in the country which itself makes it unique. The image has a height of 10.70 meter and a width of 7.70 meter. The face is depicted round with dishevelled hair. She is ten armed and is holding weapons in all the nine arms except the lower arm which holds the hair of the demon king. The weapons are mostly indistinct due to erosion and floral growth.

How to Reach:

Air - The State Capital, Agartala is well connected by air with Delhi, Kolkata, Guwahati and Chennai. The M.B.B. Airport at Agartala is 90 km away from Chabimura under Amarpur Sub-

Division of Gomati District.

Rail - The nearest rail head is Udaipur Railway Station which is about 37 km from Chabimura. One can reach Chabimura from Agartala to Amarpur by bus/cabs and thereafter 20 minutes journey by local transport. Local tourist cabs, bus etc. are available at Agartala Nagerjala bus stand/Udaipur railway station/Amarpur Motorstand to reach Chabimura.

Road - Chabimura is well connected by road with Agartala, the state capital of Tripura. Chabimura under Amarpur Sub-Division is 90 km from Agartala under Gomati District. It takes about 2.30 hours to reach Chabimura by road from Agartala. Luxury coaches both of private travel agencies and public sector Transport Corporation including tourist cabs, and small cars ply on this road.

Local Transport:

Tourist cabs, local taxi services etc. are available to and from Nagerjala bus stand, Agartala, Rajarbag bus stand, Udaipur and Amarpur bus stand to reach Chabimura on hire. Tourist cabs are also arranged by Tourism Department at Agartala Airport Tourist Information Centre on hire for local transportation.

Entry Formalities:

There is no need of entry formalities like Restricted Area Permit (RAP) or Inner Line Permit (ILP) to visit Tripura.

Nearby Attraction:

Mangal Chandi Mandir, Ramkrishna Asram, Old Rajbari, Loknath Asram, Amarpur and Narkel Kunja, and Dumboor.
